Before this, the Fr ance national football team was selected by a selection committee, a💷 pr ocess in which the French Football Federation would select coaches and trainers from within the country or abroad to prepare💷 the side for single games and tournaments, but with all decisions ultimately remaining under the control o f the committee. From💷 1904 1913, the USFSA headed the committee, which was referred to as the Commission Centrale d'Association. The committee was controlled by💷 André Espir and André Billy and featured little to no physical preparation for upcoming matches. In 1913, the Comité Fran& #231;ais💷 Interfédéral, a precursor to the French Football Fed eration, took over the committee following the USFSA becoming affiliated with th e organization💷 and secretary general Henri Delaunay took control.</p &qt;

<p&gt;Following the creation of the French Football Federation, the committee was converted into a&#128183; five-man board and lasted from 1919 1964. Gaston Barreau served as the head of the committee in two different stints; from&#12818 3; 1920 1945, then, after four years, returned to select the team from 1949 unti I his death in 1958. From 1945 1949, Gabriel&#128183; Hanot headed the committee and, following Barreau&#39;s death, Paul Nicolas (1958 1959) and Georges Verrie st (1959 1964) controlled the committee until it&#128183; was officially disband ed in 1964.&lt;/p&gt;
