(1962)[1] and early racing video games such as Astr o Race (1973).[2] The first examples of multiplayer real-time games were develop ed on the PLATO system about 1973. Multi-user games developed on this system inc luded 1973's Empire and 1974's Spasim; the latter was an early first-per son shooter. Other early video games included turn-based multiplayer modes, popu lar in tabletop arcade machines. In such games, play is alternated at some point (often after the loss of a life). All players' scores are often displayed o nscreen so players can see their relative standing. Danielle Bunten Berry create d some of the first multiplayer video games, such as her debut, Wheeler Dealers (1978) and her most notable work, M.U.L.E.
