The Ninth Ci rcuit Court of Appeals declined to grant the regulator an emergency stay &#12781 5; of a ruling that allows the deal to proceed in the US. The United Kingdom&#3 9;s Markets and Competition Authority (CMA) &#127815; is the last remaining reg ulator of note opposed to the purchase, but the watchdog and Microsoft recently agreed to put &#127815; their legal battle over the deal on hold and negotiate a compromise.&lt;/p&gt;

&lt;p&gt;Spencer did not disclose the terms of Microsoft&#39;s deal with Sony, t hough Stephen &#127815; Totilo of Axios later confirmed that it is 10 years in duration. Microsoft first offered Sony a 10-year deal to &#127815; keep Call of Duty on current and future PlayStation consoles at the end of last year, though the Japanese electronics &#127815; giant turned down the olive branch at the t ime. In an effort to secure approval from regulators, including the FTC &#127815 ; and CMA, Microsoft went on to sign an agreement with Nintendo to bring the se ries to the company&#39;s future consoles. &#127815; It also came to terms with
